On 02/05/18 at approximately 1848 hours, I responded [REDACTED] in regards to a domestic disturbance.

Upon arrival, I made contact with W/M Mario Singer. Singer advised that he got into a verbal altercation with his live in girlfriend W/F Kyle Dexter. Mario stated the argument began because Kyle was recently served an eviction notice by the Palm Beach Sheriff Office in regards to living at Mario's residence. Mario stated since the notice Kyle has been acting erratic and belligerent. Mario further stated he was worried that the altercation could become physical so he contacted BRPD for assistance. While on scene I explained to Mario that I could not ask Kyle to leave the residence being that she already established residency (Kyle receives mail at this location).

I then spoke to Kyle, It was apparent that she was upset due to her tone and attitude towards me. Kyle stated the issues with Mario are due to her infidelity within their relationship. Several times during my interaction with Kyle I had to tell her to calm down and let me speak. Kyle remained uncooperative during my investigation. At no point did the altercation become physical, neither party had injures. Mario agreed to spend the rest of the evening at his friend's house.

It should be noted that I interviewed Mario and Kyle separately, and both individuals' statements collaborated the fact that at no point was the argument physical. Both parties were issued a domestic violence pamphlet and contact information for BRPD Victim's Advocate for additional information. Mario and Kyle were issued a case card and Mario left without incident.

Recommendations were given to Mario in regards to obtaining the proper paper work from the courts in regards to a final notice date to remove Kyle from his property.
